Vision and key objectives

Vision

Match | Te Puna Taurite has a vision of an equitable, accessible and collaborative funding system for Aotearoa New Zealand.

Key objectives

- **Equity** - equity in funding distribution
- **Access** - access to the funding system for a broader range of fundseekers
- **Collaboration** - collaboration amongst funders, for better outcomes for all

What is Match | Te Puna Taurite?

Match | Te Puna Taurite is a service designed to facilitate more effective connection between funders and fundseekers.

Fundseekers:

- **Upload funding requests to get in front of multiple funders at once** (reducing grant-seeking admin/increased opportunity for funding)
- A place where you can upload your funding needs **once, in a form that suits you**
- Feedback opportunities that will **strengthen fundseeker voice** in the funding system

Funders:

- **Have an overview of all fundseekers and funding requests** – as categorised by region, impact area etc
- **Can connect with fundseekers** in order to progress the possibility of funding them
- **Collaborate with other funders** - find, understand and connect other funders who are operating in the same funding spaces as you (including in response to emergencies)

The service will have tiered fees, but be free for Tier 4 (<\$140k) charities.

What Match | Te Puna Taurite isn't:

- Not a **guaranteed place** to acquire funding
- Not a place for **non-registered charities** to acquire funding*
- Not a place where **fundseekers will be able to initiate connection to funders**
- Not a **replacement service** to other organisations (Hui E!, Strategic Grants etc) who help non-profits acquire funding. (Match | Te Puna Taurite works in parallel to existing grant rounds/other ways of acquiring funding)

**we are trialling a pilot for organisations that don't operate as legally registered charities yet are still non-profits – initially with an emphasis on kaupapa Māori groups on the East Cape*
