- SkyCity operates three Casino's and Trusts throughout New Zealand – Auckland, Hamilton and Queenstown
- Funding to the Trust is from the SkyCity Auckland Casino
- The Casino operates under a license from the Gambling Commission.
- Since we started in 1996 the Trust has distributed \$53.5mil
- To over 2,500 organisations

- Trustees define rangatahi as those that are leaving school

- Projects will bring about extensive change resulting in inter-generational impact.



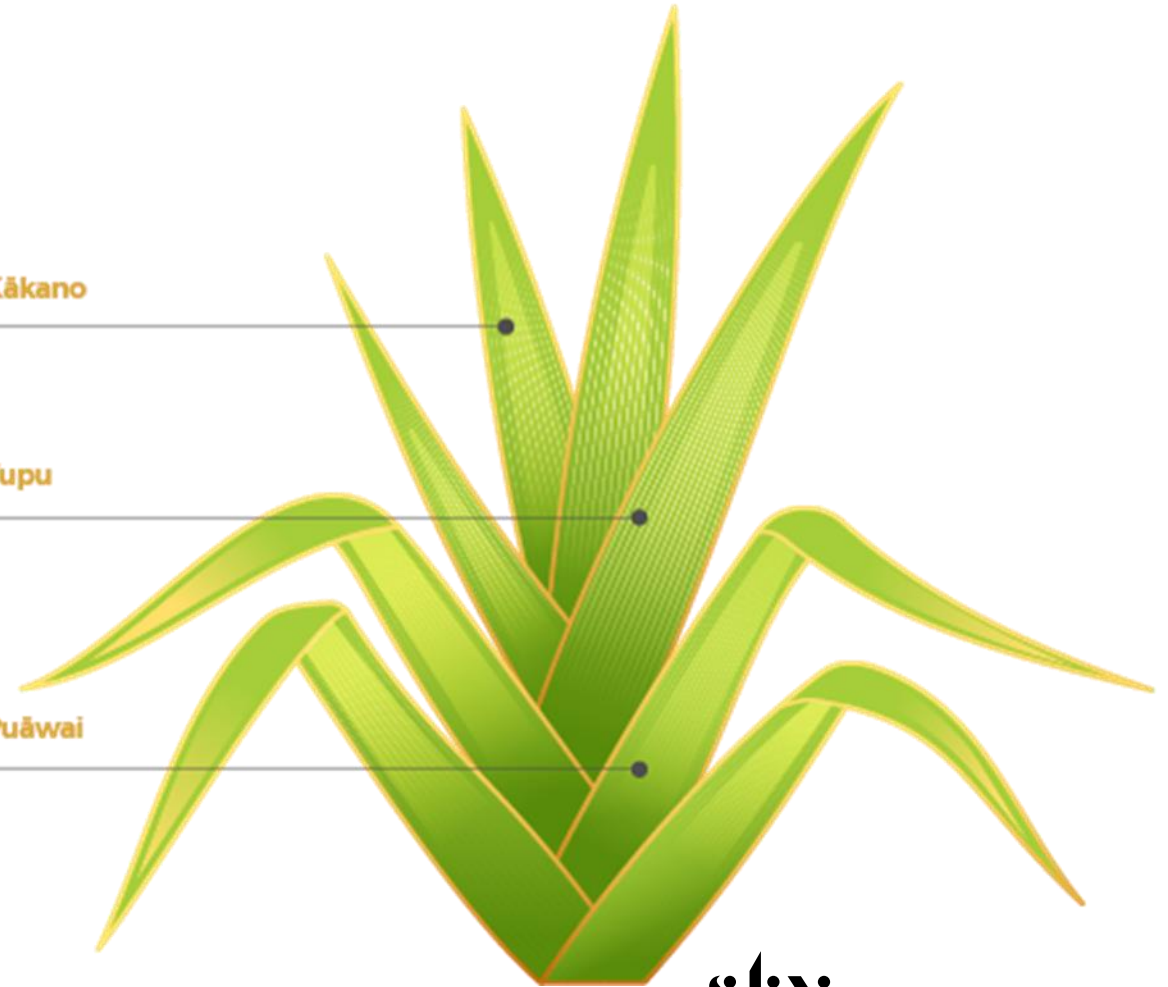

He Kākano

- New initiatives or projects; start up funding or small grants
- Decisions are made by delegated authority by the Co-Chairs
- There are no closing dates with requests processed as they are received
- For the 2022 year the Trust has approved 5 grants under He Kākano
- Grants approved range from \$2,530 to \$10,000



He Tupu

- Projects will be focused on the outcomes and priorities of the Trust.
- He Tupu is where the bulk of the Trust funding sits and application open twice each year using SmartyGrants.
- For the 2022 year the Trust provide 49 grants totalling \$2,643,890
- Grants approved ranged from \$6,300 to \$200,000
- The Trust will consider grants to cover more than one year - multiyear
- Our funding round under He Tupu is currently open and will close on Friday 12th August



He Puāwai

- He Puāwai is where the Trust funds innovations that will bring about extensive change resulting in inter-generational impact. We will also look at how we can co-invest with other funders – often for more than one year.
- An example includes of collaboration includes a multi-year grant. This has demonstrated with the programmes delivered by The Kindness Institute and co-funding with the Ministry for Youth Development.
- The Trust funded 3 grants under He Puāwai in this past financial year
- He Puāwai is a 2-stage submission process.
