# History

North Shore Presbyterian Hospital Trust established

The NSPHT ran the Lister Hospital as a not-for-profit entity for 20 years

Lister Hospital sold

Because of parking, access and noise concerns from the newly built Shore City Complex, the Trustees sold the Lister Hospital to Southern Cross for \$1,000,000

The Trust then used its capital resources to earn an income and distribute a portion each year to worthy charitable causes in the areas of physical or mental health or spiritual wellbeing.

Lister Presbyterian Health Trust established

As the Trust is no longer running a hospital, the Trustees decided to wind up the NSPHT and carry on its legacy with the Lister Presbyterian Health Trust

Members of the Presbyterian Church formed the Trust as they were concerned that the proposed repurposing of the Lister Hospital in Anzac Ave Takapuna into a motel would be a significant loss to the community.





Grant applicants are accepted from charitable organisations and individuals.

Grant applicants must be based in, or provide services to, the North Shore or Rodney areas of Auckland.

The Trustees prefer to assist with specific projects having defined outcomes rather than with day-to-day administration costs.

The ability of the Trustees to make grants is dependent by the funds available in any funding round.

All grants are made at the sole discretion of the Trustees

# What have we funded?

---

- \$8,000 for programme facilitator costs
- \$5,000 for spiritual carer salary
- \$4,000 for free counselling sessions
- \$3,000 for youth mentoring programme
- \$2,500 for workshops for disabled people
- \$2,000 for community social worker salary
- \$1,500 for staff development & external supervision
- \$600 for first-aid course for volunteers
- \$500 for resources for drop-in centre
- \$500 for journals for group participants
